1. The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments which heals and saves the baptized person from sin. The other sacrament of healing is Penance.
2. The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is the continuation of the Lord's compassion for the sick. Christ so identified with the sufferings of the sick that he made their sufferings his own.
3. The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick confers grace and this grace:
4. Those who are in danger of death from sickness or old age may receive this sacrament.
5. Priests (and bishops) may celebrate the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

"Anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, no 73)"
